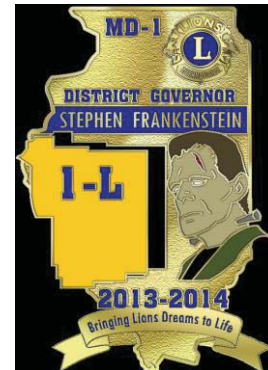


Governor Frankenstein inducted Springfield Noon Lions Club's members.

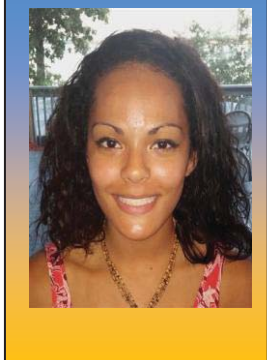
